### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Members of the ICMR task force will be present. Technical leads from organizations interested in conducting short- or long-term assessments of PMUY are encouraged to attend. Government officials from relevant agencies are also welcome. Participants will be invited to make brief presentations highlighting their capabilities and current/proposed activities as relevant. Priority will be given to organizations with relevant implementation and/or assessment efforts currently underway. Given the unprecedented scale and momentum of PMUY, of particular interest are organizations with the ability to conduct large scale assessments.

This technical workshop will facilitate the development of a comprehensive framework to assess the impact of India's efforts to increase LPG access among the poor. The framework will include potential 1) short-term assessments of current processes to expand distribution, uptake, and promotion of increased use of LPG and 2) longer-term assessments to demonstrate impacts on health and well-being. The framework will also include recommendations on partners with necessary qualifications and experience to collaborate in the implementation of a comprehensive assessment, and highlight priority opportunities to leverage ongoing efforts as well as existing sources of data.

The workshop will directly inform the Indian Council of Medical Research's (ICMR) Task Force on Impact Assessment of the PMUY's efforts to assess the short- and long-term impacts of the Ujjwala program. In addition, the framework will be used to make the case for unlocking additional funding to expand and/or complement ICMR-supported activities.
